

Incident Commander

Contacts Regional/National Coordinator and local managers (Federal, State & local resource managers, etc.) and provides daily update of incident investigation including:

- Field observations
- Number of samples obtained
- Problems/issues
- Plans for next day
- Potential action
- Quarantine recommendations

Quick report

Incident commander to report (w/in 2 weeks)

- -What you did
 - -Samples taken
 - -Photos

- -What went wrong
- -What went right
- -Who was involved
- -Initial findings

Interim report

Regional coordinator provides Interim Report (3 months)

- -Work up of ecological data.
- Preliminary lab finding.
 - -Road map findings.

- -Any other findings
- Review by Expert Working Group



Regional coordinator provides final report after review by Expert Working Group. (1 year)
